Chairman Phil Trovillo called the meeting to order at 6:04pm.

Roll Call: Trovillo, Tipton, Juniel, Mayor Verga

Motion made by Mr. Trovillo to excuse Leroy Sanders. Second by Mr. Juniel. All in favor. Motion passed.

Mr. Trovillo reports there was a problem with the salt box. It is apparently a county wide issue with bad salt.

Mr. Trovillo states we need to get the safety lights installed on the F-250. Mr. Tipton says they can come to pick the truck up anytime to be completed.

Mr. Trovillo plans to see what is wrong with the old truck. If too much needs done, we might consider putting it on GovDeals.

Mr. Trovillo states there is a light out on the corner of the maintenance garage.

Mr. Tipton reports the propane tanks were filled last week. We received 940 gallons for \$2,040. One tank was completely empty. The garage is running off the same tank as the gym. We should look into putting a separate meter on the line going to the garage.

Mr. Trovillo states we need to get ahold of Republic trash company to come get all the extra trash cans at the back of the maintenance garage.

Mr. Trovillo mentions we need to budget for cameras around the maintenance garage. There have been too many instances of people dumping tires and other various trash.

Mr. Tipton asks if we will address the stumps around town this year. He suggests renting a stump grinder.

Mr. Tipton reports that he received estimates on door replacements from Dayton Metal Door company for the gym and front entrance. The gym door will be \$4,340 and the front entrance will be \$10,700. At the very least, we need to replace the gym door.

Mr. Tipton states we should also get scissor gates for the kitchen to keep people out when it isn't being rented. They run \$300-400. He also spoke with John Boyd and he can install wifi thermostats for the gym at around \$500. This would allow us to control the temperature from an app on a phone and keep renters from changing the temperature.

Mrs. Wilkie asks if they have received the cones from the grant yet. Mr. Trovillo states he is not aware.

Motion made by Mr. Trovillo to adjourn at 6:31pm. Second by Mr. Juniel. All Aye.
