Motion made by Mr. Juniel to excuse Phil Trovillo and Leroy Sanders. Second by Mr. Tipton. Vote – Tipton, Juniel, Mayor Verga – Aye / Nay – None. Motion passed.

Mr. Tipton reports that we received the F-250 back with all safety improvements installed.

Mr. Tipton reports there were tires dumped again. However, there will be tire recycling programs held again this year with the first being April 29<sup>th</sup>. The location and time TBD.

The Village needs to look into a camera system to cover the maintenance garage and the government building. We will also need signs indicating no dumping and an associated fine.

Mr. Tipton states he spoke with Mr. Trovillo and it was agreed that we need to place the old sheet metal and drainpipe on GovDeals.

Mr. Tipton states that Joe and Bill will take the sodium lights and old police equipment to scrap.
