This is a summary of the meeting of the Harveysburg Streets & Buildings Committee held August 14, 2023, at 6:00 PM. Upon request, a recording of the meeting is available for review.

Phil Trovillo called the meeting to order at 6:00pm.

Roll Call: Tipton, Juniel, Mayor Verga, Trovillo

Motion made by Mr. Trovillo to excuse Leroy Sanders. Second by Mr. Juniel. Vote – Trovillo, Tipton, Juniel, Mayor Verga – Aye / Nay – None. Motion passed.

Motion made by Mr. Tipton to approve the July 10th minutes as written. Second by Mr. Juniel. Vote – Trovillo, Tipton, Juniel, Mayor Verga – Aye / Nay – None. Motion passed.

Mr. Juniel asks when the curbs will be finished. Mr. Trovillo states we went through about 20 gallons of good paint, and he believes we need to get more.

Mayor Verga asks if we will be crack sealing the roads soon. Mr. Trovillo states if we use the same company as before then they will furnish the machine and we will pay for the material. Mr. Tipton states he met with Jeff this afternoon and he was able to provide pricing. A skid of tar is 2250lbs which contains 75 boxes that are 30lbs each. The coverage is approximately 3-6 feet per pound. The price is

about \$0.90/lb or \$2,025/skid. Mr. Trovillo states we could start late September to early October. We will plan on at least 2 skids.

Mayor Verga suggests hiring a temporary person to complete the crack sealing work. The suggestion is to hire someone for one month.

Mr. Trovillo wants to know when we will get cameras for the maintenance garage.

Mr. Trovillo states there is a vacant house next to Kevin Martin's property that has long grass. Mayor Verga states they plan on demolishing that house.

Mr. Trovillo states the flagpole still needs to be fixed.

Ms. Herberth states that the library box from the Mary Cook Library will be similar to the old newspaper boxes. She and Mr. Trovillo were looking to put it near the sitting area in front of the building. We just need to decide and give them the go ahead.

Mayor Verga states that we need to have someone look at the leak on the roof so we can move forward with fixing it.

Motion made by Mr. Tipton to adjourn at 6:19pm. Second by Mr. Juniel. All Aye.
