This is a summary of the meeting of the Harveysburg Streets & Buildings Committee held November 13, 2023, at 6:00 PM. Upon request, a recording of the meeting is available for review.

Mark Tipton called the meeting to order at 6:05pm.

Roll Call: Tipton, Mayor Verga, Trovillo

Motion made by Mr. Tipton to excuse Leroy Sanders and Charles Juniel. Second by Mr. Trovillo. Vote – Trovillo, Tipton, Mayor Verga – Aye / Nay – None. Motion passed.

Motion made by Mr. Trovillo to approve the October 9th minutes as written. Second by Mr. Tipton. Vote – Trovillo, Tipton, Mayor Verga – Aye / Nay – None. Motion passed.

Mr. Trovillo reports that the back brakes on the silver truck need to be replaced and possibly the rotors and calipers also. It is estimated at \$800 to replace.

Mr. Tipton reports that the streetlights are still out and have not been replaced on South Street. The streetlight at North/Lorraine has not been installed.

Mr. Trovillo reports that we have two street signs missing. The locations are Wall/Main and Wall/South.

Mayor Verga states we need to have the gym roof leak checked out soon so we know what it will take to repair.

Mr. Tipton reports that the storm sewer project has been completed. Mr. Trovillo states we will need to put the markers back up at the culvert.

Mr. Tipton states that he heard back from The Hunt for Good organization. The lady was very grateful for us allowing the use of the building for a check-in.

Mr. Tipton reports we have had more complaints about Mr. Sanders property and the tree debris.

Mr. Tipton reports we had another raccoon issue, and a resident took care of it.

Mr. Trovillo reports that we have had 5 loads of leaves. Mr. Tipton asks when we want to set the last leaf pickup to be. The Committee agrees that November 22nd will be the last day of leaf pickup.

Mr. Trovillo asks if we will have a fall/spring clean-up. Mr. Tipton says we will plan a spring clean-up.
