Chairman Phil Trovillo called the meeting to order at 6:03pm.

Roll Call: Trovillo, Tipton, Juniel, Mayor Verga

Mr. Trovillo states he had Bill look at the drains in the kitchen this morning, but he's not sure if the problem has been fixed. The drains came apart or were taken apart.

Mr. Trovillo asks if we ever got the lock out kits and the extra for the garage. Chief Pottenger states he did give one to Bill.

Mr. Trovillo states everything is ready to go if we get any snow.
